### Memorial Park Tennis Courts Opening Under New Guidelines

The Town of Mamaroneck Recreation Department is announcing that the Westchester County Executive's Office has recently updated their guidelines regarding tennis court usage as outlined below:

- ⊗ Singles Play only
- ⊗ No Benches or Chairs for sitting
- ⊗ No Restrooms
- ⊗ No Congregation of Players- they must leave the area as soon as they are done playing and must not arrive more than five to ten minutes before their reserved time
- ⊗ Reservations required in advance

Due to this recent announcement, we will be opening the Memorial Park Tennis Courts for limited play, free of charge for those residing in the unincorporated portion of the Town of Mamaroneck. The courts will reopen as of Wednesday, May 13th, with the following guidelines and schedule:

Monday – Friday: 11:00am – 6:00pm

Saturday and Sunday: 10:00am – 5:00pm

#### Reservations:

Advanced reservations are required and can **only** be made by calling the tennis courts at 914-834-7074 during the established court hours listed. No in person reservations will be accepted at this time.

Players can make reservations up to seven full calendar days in advance, e.g. Monday for the following Monday.

Court usage will be limited to 55 minutes per reservation. Please exit the court on schedule so that the next group can safely rotate on.

Limit one reservation per day. We reserve the right to limit reservations if deemed necessary.

Check in is required with on duty attendant at time of arrival. Registrant will be required to show a photo I.D. verifying residency within the Town of Mamaroneck.

No lessons will be allowed.

Only three courts will be made available in order to provide better social distancing. Court #2 will be closed. Priority for Court #4 will be given to Pickleball players. Attendant reserves the right to schedule court usage accordingly.

In the event that you cannot make your scheduled reservation, please make sure to call and cancel. This will allow us to offer that court time to someone else. Any modification to an existing reservation must follow all reservation rules.

No permit required at this time.

### **Day of Play:**

Please do not arrive more than five to ten minutes prior to your reserved time.

Masks **must** be worn, and social distancing practiced while off courts.

Please practice social distancing while on the courts as best as possible.

Children **will not** be allowed to roam the facility or courts during this time.

Please bring your own water to drink and hand sanitizer. Drinking fountain and restrooms will not be available.

Please do not share equipment.

Only players will be allowed on the courts.

### **After Play:**

No congregating and players must leave facility when done playing.

### **Inclement Weather Policy:**

The on-duty attendant will make the decision if the courts are playable or not due to wet conditions. We will do our best to dry the courts off as soon as possible once the rain has ended. In the event of heavy rain, we reserve the right to close the courts for the day and cancel all existing reservations.

### **Please Note:**

The Town of Mamaroneck is committed to making the courts a safe and enjoyable place to visit and we ask that all players follow these measures in order to keep the courts open and to keep players and staff safe. The Town of Mamaroneck Recreation Department views the health and safety of our patrons and staff as our top priority.

These new procedures and hours of operation are on a temporary basis and are subject to change at any time. Non-compliance will result in the closure of the courts.

We will continue to assess our operation and closely monitor all state and county health department guidelines and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for updates. We appreciate your support and understanding as we adapt our operation during these times.
