



HOMMOCKS 2020



The Hommocks Pool is preparing to welcome its patrons back for some long-overdue fun. The pool complex will open with a limited capacity and new hours beginning June 30 through September 7.

New protocols are in place to create a safe and clean environment.

Pool Permits are not valid this summer.

Admission fee will be on a daily basis.

Here is what you can expect:

SCHEDULE AND TIME BLOCK OPTIONS:

A. SENIORS AND LAP LANE USE ONLY – ONE TIME BLOCK PER DAY FROM 9:00 - 10:00 AM

- ❖ One swimmer will be allowed per lane. Must be a minimum of 16 years old.
- ❖ This time block is also reserved for Senior Citizens (62 years old or older).
- ❖ A maximum of 16 people during time block.

B. LAP & OPEN SWIM USE – FOUR TIME BLOCKS PER DAY

10:30am – 12:30pm; 1:00 – 3:00pm; 3:30 – 5:30pm; 6:00 – 8:00pm

- ❖ A maximum of 85 people per time block.
- ❖ A total of five household family members per time block per day. Any family member under 1 year old is free and not included in the total; do not add to your cart.
- ❖ Only one swimmer will be allowed in the designated lap lane at a time.



RESERVATIONS (required for access to the pool)

- ❖ Reservations can only be made online Monday thru Friday from 9AM – 3PM (except during the July 4th three day weekend, reservations will be available online anytime up to a half hour before the time block) and will be limited to the Town of Mamaroneck residents including Village of Mamaroneck & Village of Larchmont residents (excluding Rye Neck residents).
- ❖ The Town reserves the right to verify identity.
- ❖ NO walk-ins or on-site reservations accepted. A reservation is required to ensure capacity requirements.
- ❖ Reservations can be made up to one week in advance and will be limited to one time block per day/per household.
- ❖ The daily admission fee is \$5 per person for anyone over 1 year old. A credit card convenience fee will be accessed for each transaction.
- ❖ NO GUESTS ALLOWED.
- ❖ NO RAINCHECKS, RE-ENTRY OR REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER PURCHASE.
- ❖ NO REFUNDS DUE TO RAIN OR THUNDER.

**Management reserves the right to assign spaces and to limit pool time if necessary.
The Town of Mamaroneck reserves the right to change its guidelines, policies & schedule as needed.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Patrons who are showing signs of a fever, cough, and shortness of breath or feeling sick, **PLEASE STAY HOME.**
2. Masks/face coverings, which covers both the nose and mouth, must be worn when entering and exiting the pool facility and when using the restrooms.
3. Patrons are required to maintain social distancing of 6 feet when near individuals outside of their household whether in or out of the water. Individuals must be prepared to wear a face covering if another person unexpectedly comes within six feet.
4. Patrons will be required to stay within their defined square area **“Relax Zone”** when not in the pool water. Masks are not required to be worn in the “Relax Zone”.
5. Patrons must follow rules, regulations and traffic patterns posted throughout the pool complex.
6. Please do not arrive more than 5 minutes prior to reservation time. Please plan to gather your belongings 15 minutes prior to the end of your reservation. Patrons must exit promptly at the end of their reservation through the designated exit.
7. Locker rooms and showers will **not** be available. **RESTROOMS will be available.** We encourage everyone to come and leave in his or her swimsuit.
8. Do not bring valuables to the pool, lockers will not be available. The Town will not be responsible for any valuables lost or stolen.
9. Patrons must ENTER the pool complex at the NEW designated ENTRANCE and check in with the attendant.
10. Patrons must EXIT the pool complex at the NEW designated EXIT upon leaving.
11. No furniture or tables will be provided. Patrons can bring their own chairs but must take them home. No storing of furniture.
12. **The Concession stand will NOT BE OPEN.** Outside food that fits in a small personal sized cooler will be permitted. NO LARGE COOLERS OR GLASS PERMITTED. NO FOOD DELIVERIES.
13. Please be aware of pool depth markers, obey lifeguards & no talking to lifeguards unless requesting assistance.
14. Street clothing is not permitted in the pool area. Proper swimming attire required, no cut offs.
15. Smoking is not permitted in the pool complex or restrooms.
16. No running, ball playing, or dangerous play is allowed anywhere in the pool complex.
17. The diving boards are not open to the public.
18. Adults are responsible for and must supervise any child using a swim aid (bubble/ water wings). Adults must be in the water with their child within arm’s reach at all times
19. Children 12 and under sent to the pool without adequate supervision will not be allowed admittance.
20. Town flotation equipment is not available to be used by the public and swim aids (face masks, snorkels, etc.) are not permitted in the pool without the approval of the on duty manager.
21. Babies still in the “diaper stage” are permitted in the pools with rubber pants covering a diaper, or when wearing a swim diaper.
22. Baby carriages and chairs are not permitted on the pool deck or within 5 feet of the training pool edge.
23. No music devices are permitted to be played in the pool or patio area. Personal devices may be used with headphones only.
24. Please use gender specific restrooms with children over 6 years old.
25. Management reserves the right to close certain sections and/or pools to ensure swimmer safety and meet health code requirements.
26. Pools will close upon the first clap of thunder or sighting of lightning and will remain closed until management deems it safe to reopen. All patrons must exit the complex.

CLEANING AND SANITIZING:

1. Sanitizer will be available at the entrance to the pool complex.
2. Enhanced cleaning and sanitizing of the facility will be conducted between each time block.
3. The school custodial staff will conduct an enhanced cleaning each morning before opening.
