REMINDERS & UPDATES

1. The first day of camp we encourage parents to meet the staff. Arrival begins at 9:15am. We ask that you park on Bonnie Briar Way and walk to the building. Very limited parking will be available in the gravel lot at Sheldrake.
Anyone unable to stop and meet the staff, please use the main driveway in front of the Sheldrake building to drop off your child. Please stay in your car, follow the traffic pattern, and let the counselors escort your child out of the vehicle.
2. Normal daily drop off times are between 9:15 am to 9:25 am. Pickup will be between 2:05 pm to 2:15pm. Parents will be given car passes at the end of the first day and will be assigned which lot to drop off and pick up their child.
3. Children should bring lunch and a drink daily, except on Pizza Fridays. *(See Calendar)*
4. Please send an extra change of clothing in a "zip lock" bag labeled with your child's name. This bag will remain at camp. Towels will be sent home on Fridays. Please remember to send in a clean towel on Mondays.
5. Please apply sunscreen on your child each morning before camp.
6. If your child requires medication during camp hours, please submit this form the first day of camp. [Day Camp Medication Authorization Form.](#)
7. Click on this [Camp COVID-19 protocols](#) link which, we are adhering to in conjunction with the Westchester County Board of Health regulations. Please familiarize yourself with the protocols.
8. Lastly, we received COVID-19 test kits from the Westchester County Board of Health Department, and we will be handing out two kits per camper on the first day of camp.
