The Hommocks Park Ice Rink offers Learn to Skate classes that are designed to teach the fundamentals of skating in a fun environment! We follow the guidelines of the Ice Sports Industry program that is based on consistent and well-defined levels of achievement that have proven to guide a skater from basic beginner maneuvers through significantly more advanced and even competitive skill sets.

How To Register

Registration is only available online and only during the dates and times listed under the Registration Information section.

Those who already have an online household account can register directly through the website, www.townofmamaroneckny.org/recreation. For those who are new or have not previously established an online household account. (Please plan accordingly since new accounts may take up to 2 business days to activate).

Registration is only available for one session at a time. There is no priority given to participants who are currently enrolled. Once registration begins, it will remain open online until the classes fill or until the deadline.

Classes will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Skating lessons are non-refundable and non-transferable. No refunds issued for skating lessons once registered.

Available for beginner through advanced levels for those ages 4 through Adult.

Tot 1 Beginner - Ages 4 - 6

Fall down, stand up, and march across ice without help.

Tot 1 Advanced - Ages 4 - 6

Forward swizzle, stop, two foot glide, back marching, starting to glide.

Tot 2 - Ages 4 - 6 who have already taken lessons

1 foot glide, backward swizzles, stop, forward pumping.

Pre-Alpha - Beginner - Ages 7 & up

1 foot gliding, backward swizzles, stop, forward pumping.

Sp Alpha - Ages 4 - 6 who have taken lessons

Alpha - Ages 7 & up who have taken lessons

Forward stroking, forward crossovers in each direction, backward skating, snowplow stops.

Beta - Completed Alpha Level

Backward stroking, back crossovers in each direction, t-stops both feet.

Gamma/Delta - Completed Beta Level

Gamma - Right and left outside 3 turns, right and left Mohawks, hockey stops.

Delta - Right and left inside 3 turns, forward outside and inside edges, bunny hop, lunge or shoot the duck.

Free Style 1 - Any age that has completed Gamma/Delta

Waltz jump, half flip, pivot, 2 foot spin, backward outside and inside edges, spiral.

Free Style 2 & 3 - Ballet jump, half lutz, half toe walley, 2 forward spirals, one foot spin dance step sequence. Sunday 10:15 am

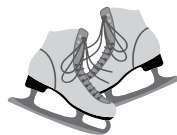
Figure Skating Camp

Helpful Skating Hints

Although our spectator area is heated, you'll want to dress warmly when you come ice skating. Snow pants, gloves and helmets are recommended. It is always better to dress in layers so you may take off a layer or two as needed.

Selecting the proper skate size is very important. Skates should be approximately one-half size smaller than your shoe size. Skates should be snug but not so tight that it is uncomfortable. You should be able to wiggle your toes. Lace the skates tightly, starting at the bottom and lacing to the top, not skipping any eyelets.
